Coming Soon: OSCAR Version 8

The following system enhancements will be deployed in January 2019:

- Accommodating students with Alternate Graduation Dates (AGD) with 2 years of law school grades
- Opt-in or opt-out feature for non-faculty recommenders and law school administrators
- Search by state in basic search and save searches





OSCAR Access Dates

Law school students graduating in 2020 will gain access to OSCAR on **February 6, 2019** to register for an account, upload documents, search for clerkship positions, and build online applications. The system will store these applications and release them to judges on **June 17, 2019**.

How Do I...Run Reports?

Law school administrators may want to run reports using data that will no longer be available after system archiving is performed. This includes reports such as Recommender Lists by School, Applicants with Applications, Last Logins of Applicants, or any other data needed for your records.
